<ul> <li>Learners will develop an understanding of chronology.</li> <li>For learners to have access to a broad and relevant curriculum with a focus on significant, local historical events and figures.</li> <li>For learners to develop an understanding of how the past impacts the present and how the present will impact the future</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Topics are designed to engage and motivate learners, enabling them to research, weigh evidence and draw their own conclusions</li> <li>Immersing learners as much as possible in the historical period that is being studied supports them in making links in their knowledge and understanding of that time and of those previously studied</li> <li>Educational visits and hands on learning opportunities are provided as often as possible to enthuse the learners and bring History to life.</li> <li>We embed historical language into all lessons, with a specific focus on relevant terms, such as yesterday, last week etc.</li> <li>Teachers will exploit relevant current events by bringing them into the learning environment</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Learners will:</li> <li>show deep engagement during history activities</li> <li>who can, show an understanding of the passage of time.
